Service Project: Students will be expected to participate in a Service Project. Projects include the Anointing Mass and luncheon for our senior citizens on Saturday, April 7, as well as other service areas our parish community is engaged in. A list of service options will be given in early spring to all confirmation students. Ordinarily, we visit three different sites throughout the final weeks of June. These include the House of Peace in Ipswich, The Agape Community in Ware, and The St. Francis and St. Theresa Catholic Worker House in Worcester.

We welcome and encourage parents to participate with their children at Sunday Mass. That way the student is introduced a bit more to our community and the meaning of celebrating the shared meal that Jesus left to us – and invites our participation as a family and a community. There is no substitute for the presence of a parent to help a child understand the gift of faith and why the Eucharist is so central to our lives. Please consider sharing these special times with your family.

We also welcome and encourage parents and families to attend the special liturgies of Holy Week before Easter, especially Holy Thursday Mass (the washing of the feet) on 3/29 and the Easter Vigil on Saturday, 3/31.
